

Club Descriptions

Art Club: Are you creative? Do you appreciate art and what it symbolizes? Then Art Club is for you!

Builders Club: This club is the largest service organization for middle school students with more than 40,000 members worldwide. The objects of Builders Club are: to provide opportunities for working together to service your school and community; to develop leadership potential; to foster the development of strong moral character; to encourage loyalty to school, community and nation. Builders Club is beginning its twelfth year at Scott Middle School. Builders Club is a leadership/service opportunity for sixth, seventh, and eighth grade students.

FCA: (Fellowship of Christian Athletes) is a group of students who meet weekly to build a caring and accepting community, make friends, and develop a balanced Christian lifestyle. Students do not have to be athletes to participate. The group is student led and its focus is on fellowship, growth, and outreach.

French Club: French Club is for any student who is interested in French culture and language. We do a number of activities (games, songs, videos, etc.) that explore French culture. Anyone interested is welcome.

Math Counts: Math Counts is looking for students who: would enjoy a challenging activity involving math; who are able to work cooperatively to solve high level word problems; are interested in competing against others in a math competition.

Media Center: An after-school study opportunity for students who wish to study or read after the school day is available in our media center. This program runs from 2:58 p.m. until 3:55 p.m. Times and dates for this program may be limited due to student participation and/or supervisor availability. Behavior expectations: a) each student should sign in upon arrival at the table near the media center inner doors b) students who arrive after 3:08 p.m. are expected to have a pass from the teacher they were with c) students may not leave the media center without asking for permission from the supervisor d) students are expected to study while they are in the media center or read quietly. Students may also research using the computer with approval of the supervisor e) students may not have loud conversations or disturb others when using the media center f) food, drink, or candy are not allowed into the media center g) students may not use personal stereos in the media center h) students need to get permission from the supervisor before using the restroom I) student who fail to follow expectations or the directions of the supervisor will be referred to the office j) continued violation of expectations may result in loss of participation in this program. Use of the media center after school is in all respects similar to media center use during the day. Students are expected to follow all rules as listed in the Scott Middle School handbook or procedures as established by Scott staff and administration.

Fitness Club: Open Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 3:00-3:55 p.m. for the 2007-2008 school year. Come down and lift weights, ride the exercise bike or jump rope. Everyone who wants to work out is welcome.

Student Council: This is a service organization. It provides opportunities for members to develop leadership skills as they organize service projects for the school and community, and coordinate activities to promote school spirit. The council works through committees, each of which is responsible for a different aspect of school/community relations. The council also provides for an exchange of ideas among the administration and student body through its student representatives. Membership: all students shall be eligible for an unlimited number of terms on Student Council. Duties: to act as a representative of his/her grade; to attend regular meetings and committee sessions; take part in discussion and voting; to perform any other duties assigned.

T.I.E. Club: (Teens Influencing Equity) is the multicultural club at Scott Middle School. Members of this club focus on multicultural, equity issue as they relate to Scott Middle School. A major activity for the club is planning a special program that honors both Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and a community person who has worked toward helping to carry on the dream of Dr. King. The club sponsors at least one community service project a year.
